ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL PERSONS TO REMOVE SNOW FROM THE SIDEWALKS IN FRONT OF RESIDENCES AND IN FRONT OF BUSINESSES.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Mayor and Council that all sidewalks within the Borough of Cochranon be kept free of snow in order to protect the health, welfare and safety of individuals in Cochranon Borough.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORAINED AND ENACTED, by the Mayor and Borough Council for and of the Borough of Cochranon and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1: All persons shall remove snow from their sidewalks within a reasonable time after a snow fall, but no later than 8:30 a.m. the following day.

SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful for any person to cover or block a fire hydrant with snow.

SECTION 3: It shall be unlawful to throw, push or blow snow back into the streets after said street had been plowed.

SECTION 4: It shall be unlawful to place snow on or about the streets of the Borough of Cochranon in such a manner that it will interfere with the flow of traffic.

SECTION 5: The Borough of Cochranon shall have the right to post or close any street in order to remove a heavy snow fall within the Borough limits.

SECTION 6: The Borough of Cochranon shall have the right to request the removal of any vehicle or to have removed any vehicle that interferes with snow removal. In the event the vehicle shall be towed away by Borough employees, or towed away at the request of Borough employees, the vehicle owner shall be responsible for the towing charges.

SECTION 7:

ENFORCEMENT: All persons found in violation of this ordinance shall first be given a verbal warning, if said person refuses to comply with this ordinance, said person shall be guilty of a summary offense. The fine shall be in an amount not to exceed \$300.00. The Borough shall also have the right to have said snow removed and the cost to be added to the fine.
